General Description:

A healthy digestive system is essential to the overall health of your pet. A normal intestinal tract can maintain the proper balance of harmful and beneficial bacteria. However, during times of stress, the balance of intestinal bacteria can become altered and lead to signs of digestive upset including vomiting, diarrhea, and flatulence. Probiotics are microorganisms that when given in certain doses can improve digestion, provide essential nutrients, strengthen the immune system, and can minimize the growth of disease-causing bacteria. Probiotics are available in the form of powders, liquids, paste, capsules and tablets.

What is this product?

This digestive supplement may contain the following ingredients:

Probiotics such as Lactobacillus, Bifidobacterium, and Streptococcus are live and naturally occurring microorganisms that help to restore balance in the digestive system

Prebiotics are complex carbohydrates such as fructooligosaccharides (FOS) and mannanoligosaccharides (MOS) which support probiotics and help to maintain normal balance in the digestive system

Reasons for using this product:

This is a supplement that promotes gastrointestinal health and helps to normalize intestinal function

Probiotics may assist those pets that have digestive upset due to antibiotics use, dietary indiscretion, food sensitivities, stress from from kenneling or transportation, or other gastrointestinal related conditions

Animal Precautions:

This product is recommended for use in cats and dogs and should be administered only when and as prescribed by a licensed veterinarian

Use of this product in any other species should be in consultation with a veterinarian

Use of this product in animals with any of the following conditions should be limited to those who are under the supervision of a veterinarian:

Critically ill, dehydrated, severe vomiting

Immunocompromised pets

Safety has not been established in:

Pregnant or nursing animals

Animals with a known hypersensitivity or allergy to this or related products should not be given this medication

Probiotics may be sold without a prescription (OTC/over the counter) but should be used under the supervision of your veterinarian

Directions:

Probiotics should be given according to your veterinarian's instructions. Read and follow the product label carefully. Depending on your pet's response, your veterinarian may adjust the administration amount.

It is recommended that this supplement be given for only as long as your veterinarian directs as these supplements are commonly intended for intermittent or supplemental feeding.

This medication should take effect within 1 to 2 days. You should see improvements in your pet's clinical signs.

It is ideal to give this supplement at the same time daily.

Supplements are not regulated by the FDA. As such, they have not been required to go through the same rigorous testing for efficacy that drugs undergo and many products are not created equally. Many products on the market are high quality and are made by reputable companies. Some products require a veterinary prescription. Consult with your veterinarian to choose the right product for your pet.

What if a dose is missed?

If a dose is missed, give it as soon as you can. If it is time already for the next dose, skip the missed dose and go back to the normal schedule. Do not give two doses at the same time.

What to tell/ask your veterinarian before giving this product?

Talk to your veterinarian about:

The signs of digestive upset that you have noted

What tests may need to be performed prior to and during treatment with this supplement

When your pet may need to be re-examined

What are the safety concerns when using this product in different species

What are the risks and benefits of using this supplement

Tell your veterinarian about:

If your pet has experienced side effects on other drugs/products

If your pet has experienced any other medical problems or allergies

If your pet has experienced digestive upset now or ever

All medicines and supplements that you are giving your pet or plan to give your pet, including those you can get without a prescription. Your veterinarian may want to check that all of your pet's medications can be given together.

If your pet is pregnant, nursing or if you plan to breed your pet in the near future

Storage and Warnings:

Probiotics should be stored in a childproof container in a cool, dry place at room temperature away from heat and direct sunlight.

Keep this and all medication out of reach of children and pets.

Call your physician immediately if you accidentally take this product.

Potential side effects:

This product is usually well tolerated and adverse reactions are uncommon at recommended doses

Notify your veterinarian immediately if your pet experiences any adverse reactions to this product

This short-acting medication should stop working within 24 hours, although effects may last longer in pets with liver or kidney disease

Can this drug be given with other medications?

Do not give new food, supplements, or medications without first talking to your veterinarian

If your pet experiences any unusual reactions when taking multiple medications, contact your veterinarian

What should I do if I know of or suspect there has been an overdose?

Contact your veterinarian immediately if your pet receives more than the recommended amount.

What else should I know?

Notify your veterinarian if your pet's condition does not improve or worsens despite this treatment.

As with all supplements, it should only be given to the pet for which it was recommended.
