GENERAL DESCRIPTION: Sodium Hyaluronate is an eye drop useful in dogs and cats needing relief from eye surface problems, e.g. 'dry eye'.

WHAT IS THIS DRUG?

Eye drops containing hyaluronic acid and glycerin

REASONS FOR PRESCRIBING:

Useful in dogs and cats with allergies, or those with moderate to severe dry eye (Keratoconjunctivitis sicca or KCS)

DIRECTIONS:

Use the exact amount prescribed and only as often as directed.

Use this medication for as long as your veterinarian directs. Do not skip doses or stop giving the medication without consulting your veterinarian.

When using multidose containers, avoid contamination by not touching tip of container to any surface, including the eye.

When using single use containers, after each treatment, dispose of unit container and its contents.

This product will take effect quickly and improvement in clinical signs should follow.

Ideally, give medication at the same time(s) daily.

WHAT IF A DOSE IS MISSED?

If a dose is missed, give it as soon as you can. If it is time already for the next dose, skip the missed dose and go back to the normal schedule.

WHAT TO TELL/ASK YOUR VETERINARIAN BEFORE GIVING THIS MEDICATION?

Talk to your veterinarian about:

When will your pet need to be rechecked

What are the risks and benefits of using this drug

Tell your veterinarian about:

If your pet has experienced side effects on other drugs/products

If your pet has experienced any other medical problems or allergies now or ever

All medicines and supplements that you are giving your pet or plan to give your pet, including those you can get without a prescription. Your veterinarian may want to check that all of your pet's medicines can be given together.

STORAGE AND WARNINGS:

Store at room temperature away from heat and direct sunlight. Protect from freezing.

Keep this and all medication out of reach of children and pets.

POTENTIAL SIDE EFFECTS:

If your pet experiences eye pain or discomfort, continued redness or irritation of the eye for more than 24 hours, or if the condition worsens, discontinue use and consult your veterinarian as soon as possible.

This short-acting product should stop working in a couple of hours

CAN THIS DRUG BE GIVEN WITH OTHER MEDICATIONS?

This product may modify the effects of other eye drops or eye medications. Do not use with other eye drops or eye medications without consulting your veterinarian.

WHAT ELSE SHOULD I KNOW?

 $Notify your \ veterinarian \ if your \ animal's \ condition \ does \ not \ improve \ or \ worsens \ despite \ this \ treatment.$

As with all prescribed medicines, these drops should only be given to the pet for which it was prescribed. It should be given only for the condition for which it was prescribed.
